Having been presented brief synopses of several books by African-American authors, children attended a reading and discussion of one of their selected books, ranging from Catching the Moon to The Day You Begin to I, Too, Am America to Mae Among the Stars in small, cozy settings. The National African American Read-In, the nation's first and oldest event dedicated to diversity in literature, was established in 1990 by the Black Caucus of the National Council of Teachers of English to make literacy a significant part of Black History Month. 

Parenting Children with ADHD: The Three Essential Strategies all Families Should Know
