OVERVIEW

The Miquon Day Camp Certified Pool Operator (CPO) is responsible for maintaining the safety, cleanliness, and regulatory compliance of the camp's swimming pool and aquatic facilities. This role oversees water quality, chemical treatment, and pool mechanical systems to ensure a safe swimming environment for campers and staff.

The CPO works closely with the Pool Manager and camp leadership to support daily aquatic operations but is not responsible for lifeguard supervision or direct camper supervision.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Pool Operations & Water Quality

- Perform daily water quality testing (pH, chlorine, alkalinity, and other required parameters) and document results in accordance with local and state health regulations
- Adjust and apply pool chemicals to maintain safe and compliant water chemistry
- Maintain filtration, pumps, heaters, and automated systems, and ensure proper operation of pool equipment
- Maintain cleanliness and safety of pool mechanical areas and decks as required

Safety & Regulatory Compliance

- Ensure the aquatic facility complies with all applicable health codes, licensing requirements, and camp policies
- Maintain required operational logs, inspection reports, and compliance documentation
- Identify and respond to equipment malfunctions; coordinate repairs with facilities staff or outside vendors
- Collaborate with camp leadership to develop and enforce pool safety standards and procedures

Collaboration & Communication

- Work closely with the Pool Manager and Camp Director to ensure the pool is ready for daily camper use
- Communicate facility concerns, hazards, or compliance issues immediately to camp leadership
- Support aquatic staff with technical guidance during safety incidents or operational issues

QUALIFICATIONS

- Current Certified Pool Operator (CPO) certification (NSPF or equivalent) required
- Strong knowledge of pool chemistry, filtration systems, and aquatic safety standards
- Prior experience operating and maintaining swimming pools preferred
- CPR and First Aid certification preferred
- Ability to lift up to 50 pounds and work outdoors in varying weather conditions
- Successful completion of all criminal and child protection screenings

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

- Ability to lift, carry, and move pool equipment and chemical containers
- Ability to kneel, bend, climb ladders, and access mechanical areas
- Comfortable working outdoors in sun, heat, humidity, and variable weather conditions
