Responsible for providing medical care, managing medications, and responding to health-related emergencies, the Camp Nurse ensures that every camper has a safe and enjoyable summer experience.

The ideal candidate is organized, compassionate, and able to handle a variety of medical situations calmly and efficiently. In addition to addressing immediate health needs, the Camp Nurse works collaboratively with camp leadership to maintain a healthy camp environment and educate staff and campers on proper health practices.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Medical Care & Emergency Response

- Provide first aid, treatment, and care for illnesses and injuries as needed
- Administer medications according to written instructions and maintain accurate records
- Respond quickly and effectively to emergencies, following established procedures
- Serve as a calm, professional, and supportive presence for campers and staff

Health Oversight & Prevention

- Monitor camper and staff health, identifying and addressing potential health concerns promptly
- Ensure all health and safety protocols are followed by campers and staff
- Provide guidance to staff on health-related issues, including hygiene, illness prevention, and emergency response

Records & Documentation

- Maintain accurate health records for all campers and staff
- Document incidents, treatments, and follow-ups in accordance with camp policies
- Use the camp application to review camper health records, log visits, track medication administration, and manage other health documentation efficiently

Communication & Collaboration

- Communicate health updates and concerns to camp leadership and families as appropriate
- Participate in staff training, planning meetings, and camp activities as appropriate
- Collaborate closely with camp leadership to ensure a safe, healthy, and positive environment

Facilities & Supplies

- Maintain a safe, sanitary, and organized health office
- Manage inventory of medical supplies and ensure adequate stock for the season

QUALIFICATIONS

- Current Registered Nurse (RN) license in good standing in Pennsylvania
- Experience in pediatric or camp nursing, first aid, and emergency response preferred
- Current CPR and First Aid certification required
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills, with the ability to remain calm in emergency situations
- Ability to manage and organize health records and related paperwork; experience with CampSite or similar camp application is a plus
- Comfortable and proficient with using a computer for record-keeping and communication
- Must pass background checks and meet all local licensing and health requirements

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

- Ability to be on your feet for extended periods and move quickly in emergencies
- Ability to lift or assist campers as needed (up to 50 lbs)
- Capacity to respond promptly to health and safety situations in indoor and outdoor settings
